Vainikkala and Buslovskaja Track Work Affects Rail Services

Extensive track work is underway on Finnish and Russian rail networks to improve the capacity and efficiency of rail traffic between the two countries.

At the moment the upgrade work has progressed in Finland to Vainikkala rail yard and in Russia to Buslovskaja rail yard and to line section Vyborg–Buslovskaja.

Rail services are temporarily reduced due to the upgrade work and train inspections and Russian Customs operations are subject to special arrangements.

The special conditions cause delays of 1–3 days depending on daily traffic conditions to transports from Finland to Russia.

All rail services are stopped 21–26 June 2010 as new tracks are connected to the rail network.

The rail service alterations are expected to end on 26 June 2010.
